Our Medication Solution

VRI's Medication Dispenser is a home-based, medication compliance system that helps manage multiple medications and reduces the risk of missed or double doses. These dispensers can administer solid medications up to four times a day, and has audio and visual reminders.



live monitoring

Our wireless interface enables 24/7 live monitoring so in the event that a medication dose is missed, one of our Care Center professionals will complete a live outreach to the participant.



address adherence barriers

We provide live outreach to participants when they miss a dose to help identify the barriers to adherence and partner with their care circle to address.



medication safety

Medications are locked securely. With access by key-only, caregivers can easily monitor patient compliance.



audio & visual alarms

An audible alarm will sound when it is time to take medication. For the hearing impaired, a flasher will also signal when it is time to take the next dose.



power settings

VRI's medication dispenser utilizes AC power. When the device is not connected to power, it will switch to its rechargeable battery.
